SONNY SWANGSTU RETIRES AS COMMANDER OF AMERICAN LEGION POST 59

After thirteen years as Commander of American Legion Post 59, Sonny Swangstu has retired from the leadership post. The 81-year-old Air Force veteran has held the position since taking over from past commander, Bill Redepenning, in 2008.

Archie Christensen, also an Air Force veteran, and long-time membership chairman of Post 59, says, "Sonny's actions, as commander, have given our post many improvements that will have a lasting effect on the posts future".

After graduating from Stoughton High School, Sonny signed a contract to play professional baseball as a pitcher with the Washington Senators. After an arm injury cut short his professional baseball career, he joined the United States Air Force where he served for four years, mostly in the country of Libya. Upon his return, he joined American Legion Post 59 where he has been a steady influence on membership and growth.

Sonny took over as commander of Post 59, which currently has a membership of 376, shortly after the Post had purchased the present home at 803 North Page Street. As not only the leader, but also the worker, the 48-year American Legion member hit the ground running. The first major project he took on was remodeling the building and tearing up the floor to install an upto-date drainage system. His latest project, finished on July 18 of this year, was complete remodeling of the kitchen pantry, including the installation of new shelving and cupboards. In between, he worked continuously making improvements not only to the physical plant, but also to the services rendered by the post to the Stoughton community.

Other major projects: Sonny singlehandedly built the new, enlarged, more efficient bar. He was responsible for getting the outdoor Tiki bar built, the garage addition, improvements to the bathrooms, front and back entryways, the smoker addition, and the cooler area. He helped organize the Sons of American Legion. He was responsible for purchasing the van which is used by the Post 59 Funeral Honor Guard, of which Sonny is an active member.

Of all the things to feel good about, Sonny says, "the building of the Stoughton Area Veterans Memorial Park was the project I feel best about". When the veteran's memorial park committee was formed, Sonny approached Oscar and Shirley Linnerud about purchasing land for the memorial. A few weeks later, the Linneruds donated the three acres upon which the memorial now stands. Sonny then served on the construction committee from 2014 and is still on that committee. He was recognized for his efforts by being named Stoughton Area Volunteer of The Year in 2017.

Next on the "feel good" list, Sonny says, "Being elected as commander for 13 years by my fellow comrades, and bettering the post, in general. The Post is a good, safe place to gather; we have gained membership, and we are free of debt".

Lastly, Sonny wishes to thank all those fellow veterans and community members who have helped him and the Post.

Jim Oler, ex-marine, and current Post 59 finance officer for the past eleven years, sums it up. "Sonny accomplished a lot as our commander, not as a delegator, but as a hands-on type of person. He will be dearly missed. Enjoy your retirement, my friend".

Greetings everyone,
