

The Dane County Veterans Service Office: Dan Connery and his staff can assist veterans and their families in determining eligibility and application in applying for benefits and services. They will review your need and if they cannot assist will refer you to the appropriate authority. When I am asked about veteran's eligibility and where to start, I always refer them to this office. 
